If in the unfortunate circumstance you wound an animal with a poor shot, you and your guide will return to the range to make sure your equipment is functioning properly. If you decide after the range time that you would like to take another chance, we would ask you to make a \$1,000 donation towards taking a deserving youth hunting. We hope that you understand this policy, and we also hope that you are able to make a great, well placed shot on your animal of a lifetime!

ABOUT OUR HUNTS

Elk Hunts- we operate in southern NM in units 17,13,15,16's, 36, 34, & 10 which are known to hold some of the biggest trophy caliber bulls of the western states. Our goal is to kill mature bulls scoring 330" or better, but ultimately what makes you happy. Units 17, 13, & 15 are bow & muzzleloader only, allowing more bulls to grow to maturity. Scopes & inline muzzleloaders are allowed. Units 16E, & 10 have a much better chance of drawing a tag, but not as many giant bulls.

Archery - September 1-14 (early rut) & 15-24 (peak rut) (5-6) day hunts with the option to add days September 1- 7 is generally pre-rut with warmer days, spot and stalk, hunting water sources and in between bedding grounds is very effective. Advantages of being the first hunters of the year and hunting mature bulls that aren't cow'd up. September 7-14 the rut is kicking off and the bulls are starting to come alive! September 15 - Oct 14 is known to be the peak of the rut. Average shot 20 – 50 yards but please practice out to 70 and as far as you can, it will dramatically help your game.

Crossbow (allowed with a doctor's note approved by NMDGF)

***YOUTH SPECIAL: Peak Rut Hunt** - early October (5) days
One of the best experiences for hunting bugling bulls with tons of action!

***MOBILITY IMPAIRED** - early October Rut (5) days (need to send in doctors note before draw)
Probably the best experience for hunting bugling bulls with tons of action!

Muzzleloader only units - October - November (5) day hunt, units 17, 13, & 15 generally the tail end of the rut. November hunting Bachelor bulls. Average shot 80 - 350 yards

Late November Bachelor Bulls Hunt - A great opportunity at glassing a giant bull in a bachelor herd after the rut! (Requires hunter to be in good physical condition to access the high country). Please notify me if you're interested and capable of this high demand hunt!

Rifle - October - November (5) day hunt, units 10, 12, 16's, 34, & 36 generally the tail end of the rut. November hunting Bachelor bulls.

Meals & Lodging included - we offer ranch house or lodge hunts, archery canvas wall tent hunts under the stars with a camp fire setting, or an *upgrade to a 5-star fancy lodge or B&B with fine dining & amenities, all depending on the experience you're looking for, and where we've located the best game! If you have a preference, please specify.

Style of hunting – we use 4-wheel drive vehicles, and Polaris rangers to navigate to different hunting locations. Depending on what phase the elk are in and the style of hunting you prefer, we hunt water sources with blinds or tree stands, in between bedding areas, spot & stalk, and sneaking in on big bugling bulls during the rut! We have been scouting bulls throughout the entire season and are prepared to adapt to the best means of killing big bulls! This is our Lifeblood, our Passion, and we do it for the Love Of the Hunt. If you would like to experience this with us please make sure you have the same outlook and are in it for the right reasons!

ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER OF LIABILITY, COVENANT NOT TO SUE, AND AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS

Please read carefully before signing
This is a release of liability and waiver of certain legal rights.

In consideration for my being permitted to participate in the activities of guided hunting through Gerald Blake and LOH Outfitters (hereinafter "Releasees"), I do hereby acknowledge, understand and agree as follows:

1. That participation in guided hunting through LOH Outfitters involves certain DANGERS, including, but not necessarily limited to, those associated with the discharge of firearms by myself and others, risk of injury from handling firearms and other equipment, risk of being in proximity to others using such firearms and equipment, risk of injury from walking in rugged terrain and the natural erosion to property and roadways, risk of injury from encounters with animals, insects, reptiles, and other wildlife, domesticated and undomesticated, risk of injury from riding horses or other animals, risk of injury from use of blinds or tree stands erected by myself or others, risk of injury from riding all-terrain vehicles (ATV) or any other vehicles used on or off road, risks associated with physical activity and risks associated with inclement weather conditions. I fully understand and appreciate these risks, the nature of guided hunting and inherent RISKS of injury, loss of life, and property damage, and CONSENT TO ASSUME SUCH RISKS. I further acknowledge that personal safety during guiding hunting is the responsibility of each participant.
2. I understand that the activities involved in guided hunting require good physical conditioning and degree of skill and knowledge. I expressly represent to Releasees that I have NO MEDICAL CONDITION or physical limitation which would adversely affect my ability to participate in this program and that I have the requisite skill, knowledge, and preparation for such activity.
3. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary. I knowingly and freely elect to participate in such activity despite the associated risks and ASSUME all such RISKS, known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of Releasees or others, and assume and accept full responsibility for my participation, with full knowledge of the inherent risks, hazards, and dangers involved, including property damage, bodily injury, paralysis, and death.
4. I, for myself, my heirs, successors, executors, subrogates and assigns, hereby knowingly and intentionally WAIVE AND RELEASE, INDEMNIFY and HOLD HARMLESS, Releasees, their directors, officers, agents, employees, assigns, and volunteers, from and against any and all claims, actions, causes of action, liabilities, suits, expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees and disbursements) related to, arising out of, or in any way connected to my participation in guided hunting through LOH Outfitters, including, but not limited to, NEGLIGENCE of any kind or nature, whether foreseen or unforeseen, arising directly or indirectly out of any loss, injury, damage, paralysis or death to me or others, or damage to my property or property of

others, as a result of engaging in this activity or use of these services, animals, or equipment, whether such damage, loss, injury, paralysis or death results from my negligence, the negligence of Releasees or from some other cause, and further COVENANT and agree NOT TO SUE Releasees as a result of any injury or losses sustained in connection with my participation in the activities of guided hunting with Releasees, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

5. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual, significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest representative and official immediately.

6. This Release of Liability and Agreement to Indemnify and Hold Harmless shall be binding on me (and any youth participant for whom I am authorizing participation), and my/our heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors and assigns, and shall inure to the benefit of the Releasees, their officers, directors, agents, heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, assigns and successors in office.

7. Unless I am able to make a reasoned decision to refuse such assistance at the time it is offered, I give permission to have emergency first aid administered to me at the sole discretion of the agency representative(s) operating/in charge of this event, and, if they deem it appropriate, to transport me by the most expedient means of conveyance to the nearest physician, hospital or clinic at my cost.
